To have a deeper engineering knowledge he went to the School of Technical Sciences of Budapest in the faculty of CAD/CAM design. His graduation thesis paper on Tourbillon watch was honored with Diploma Prize by the Chamber of Engineering in Budapest.

As an inheritor of the watch family, he received a very orthodox watch education. But when BQ reporter asked him how he thought about such education, he gave us an unexpected answer. In fact, it's not necessary to get a formal education as it depends on which part of watch industry one would like to be working at. As Aaron Becsei takes charge of all the departments of his company (except for the non-manufacturing parts like administration, marketing etc. which are managed by his wife), therefore he can use that knowledge well in his professional life. But for someone who is interested in assembling

who designed the movement and the case, and who made it by part, who finished with his hands all the part one by one assembled the entire watch. As an independent watchmaker, is what he is most proud of.

Every day, Aaron Becsei works in his workshop for more to 10 hours. And those independent watchmakers always last on how obsessively each of them works.
